Notes on travel costs

This benefit applies when a specialist recommends eligible in-patient or day-patient treatment that is not available on the Isle of Man. Benefit will be available to reimburse travel costs up to a limit of £300 each return trip. This provides benefit for all incurred travel costs between the Isle of Man and the intended medical facility on mainland Great Britain or the nearest available facility. Limited to 6 return trips each member every scheme year. Please note, as an Isle of Man customer, if a member's treatment is available on the Isle of Man, but they choose to use a facility that is not on the Isle of Man, travel costs won't be paid for.

Treatment must be medically necessary and be for, or directly related to, eligible in-patient or day-patient treatment and be specifically on the recommendation of a specialist.
